



NCRCC Flying Protocol

When you arrive at the field:

- 2.4 Ghz – Put your AMA membership card on the frequency board.
- 72 Mhz – Put your transmitter in the impound with your AMA membership card affixed to it.
- Wear your NCRCC member badge.

Waiting to fly:

- Range check your radio.
- Prepare your equipment.
- Observe the other activity going on at the field.

Preparing to fly:

- 72 Mhz – Put your AMA membership card on the matching frequency pin – impound.
- No aircraft pre-flight preparation under the pavilion.
- Ensure that your aircraft is restrained; respect electric start-up possibility.
- Check all R/C functions with engine/motor running.
- Observe what's going on prior to taxiing your aircraft.
- Taxi or carry your aircraft to the pilot station area – recheck all functions.

Flying:

- Takeoff with first turn away from the pit area.
- Fly and land only on the far side of the berm.
- Communicate your intentions to the other pilots who are flying.

Returning to the pit area:

- Shut down your engine, disarm electrics, before crossing the stop line on the taxiway.
- Carry or tow your aircraft back to the pit area.
