



Camping Guidelines

These guidelines will allow safe camping activity while fully adhering to the AMA Safety Code and all NCRCC rules.

- 1) Only NCRCC club members will be allowed to camp on club property and camping must be done in conjunction with active flying activities over that period. The Activities Director must be notified in advance of all planned camping activity.
 - 1a) During AMA-sanctioned events, camping may be allowed for outside participants through prior arrangement with the event's Contest Director. Approval will depend upon availability of camping sites and in accordance with all NCRCC camping guidelines.
- 2) Camping can take place for up to two consecutive nights (or up to three consecutive nights during national holidays).
- 3) Tent camping is allowed.
- 4) Physical placement of motor coaches/RV trailers and tents must take into account the AMA Safety Code and not interfere with flying activities. All camping shall take place only in the designated area (parking area to the left of the storage containers). No unattended camping vehicles or equipment may be stored on club property.
- 5) Up to two guests of a club member may stay with a club member in their camping unit. Members are fully responsible for guests.
- 6) NO illegal activity or reckless behavior is allowed at the field.
- 7) Campers will be fully responsible for any damage caused to club property by their camping activity.
- 8) Campers are NOT allowed to discharge any "dark or grey water" on club property.
- 9) ALL trash related to the camping activity will be removed by the campers. This trash must NOT be discarded in the club dumpster.
- 10) Sound abatement after dusk and before 7 AM must be strictly enforced to maintain NCRCC's "good neighbor" status. All generators must meet National Park Service requirements (≤ 60 db at 50 feet). No loud/offensive noise(s) from attendees, equipment, actions, or flying activity are permitted.
